The Cardiff Sixth Form Scholarship programme is robustly administered and highly valued. It is a meritocratic process which takes into account the achievements of the applicants, their performance at interview and their passion for their chosen career. There is a strong focus on academic achievement.

In accepting the scholarship awarded to you by Cardiff Sixth Form College you are required to meet the obligations detailed below –

- To achieve an average attendance of 95% over the academic year and to be punctual at all times.
- To maintain a high standard of academic attainment throughout the year. Minimum attainment required is AAA with 85% average in each subject in your examinations (EP's).
- If you obtain a college sanction we reserve the right to review your scholarship.
- To attend the annual Cultural Event, Glee production, Sports Day, Eisteddfod and any other college activities / events which are a part of the college calendar and in which you are not formally participating.
- To be willing to participate in college activities and the college house system.
- To actively promote the college's Scholarship system.
- To represent the college by being a role model in terms of attitude and behaviour. On occasions you may be asked to attend college promotional events.
- AS examination results must contain a minimum of AAA to maintain the full scholarship. If results are lower than this a partial scholarship for the A2 year may be offered or the scholarship may be withdrawn should attainment fall below AAB.

- Maintenance of the scholarship throughout the A2 year will be judged on the basis of your attainment in the EP cycles and mock examinations as well as all other criteria such as behaviour, attitude, attendance and participation.
- Please note that the college normally requires at least 4 students to run a subject. If you undertake a subject that has less than 4 students at any time during the course, the college reserves the right to withdraw this subject from the curriculum or to offer it on a separate charged basis.

Request to parents

- Parents are requested to offer their support at international and local exhibitions/promoting the interest of the college where possible.
- Parents are requested to assist with work experience provision if appropriate.

Regular meetings will be held throughout the year with the Head of House to discuss individual progress and to ensure that the above conditions are being satisfied.
